Public Comments (3 minutes each) – An opportunity for the public to address the Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 Board of Directors on agenda items or concerns not on the agenda – those wishing to speak must complete the blue comment card, present the comment card to the District's Executive Assistant prior to the beginning of the meeting, and observe a three-minute time limit. Members of the public who utilize a translator to address the Board shall be allowed six (6) minutes to address the Board.

- G. Approve the minutes of May 11, 2021.
- H. Business session:
 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received since May 11, 2021, that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 2. Acknowledge the receipt and filing of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's Investment Schedule for May 31, 2021, pursuant to Section 2256.023 of the Public Funds Investment Act.
 - 3. In connection with the ALERT Upgrade grant contract (TWDB Contract No. 1800012311), consider a resolution approving the "TWDB's Adjusted Budget Memorandum No. 1" reallocating funds within the existing task and expense budgets.

- 4. Consider a resolution authorizing Drainage District No. 6's nominee for the Jefferson Central Appraisal District Board of Directors for the 2022-2023 term of office.
- 5. Consider a resolution approving a second extension of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's existing "Depository Contract" with Wells Fargo Bank through July 30, 2021, with no changes to the current contract.
- 6. In connection with an \$8,500,000 Watershed Flood Protection Planning Study Grant (Regional Watershed Plan) acknowledge the execution of "TWDB Commitment No. GN1001280" authorized by the Board on March 9, 2021, and ratify the execution of an "Escrow Agreement" with Allegiance Bank related to this commitment contract.
- 7. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of 5-year "Surface Use Agreement #0521AP0550" between the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) and Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (DD6), allowing DD6 to construct a hydrological monitoring gauge on property owned by TPWD (Sea Rim State Park) for the purposes of monitoring water levels and possible storm surges in real time, with 5-year renewal options at Grantor's discretion.
- 8. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Inter-Local Agreement" between Jefferson County, Drainage District No. 6, and the Texas Department of Transportation regarding work to be performed as part of the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery Program, pursuant to Chapter 791 Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act, in connection with the replacement of the Hwy-124 bridge over Taylor's Bayou; in connection with the District's Taylor's Bayou Drainage Improvements Project.
- 9. To provide improved drainage to the area of South Broadway Street in China, Texas, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Interlocal Government Agreement" between Drainage District No. 6 and the City of China, wherein Drainage District No. 6 will perform a one-time cleanout of the road ditch along S. Broadway Street.
- 10. In connection with the Professional Services Agreement (PROF 21-009) with Tolunay-Wong Engineers for the geotechnical engineering work for the District's Fleet Maintenance & Storage Building, approved on April 13, 2021, consider a resolution approving "Change Order No. 1" increasing the contract's not to exceed amount from \$8,525.00 to \$9,605.00 (increase of \$1,080.00), to provide testing of the select fill material that will be used for the building's foundation.
- 11. In connection with MK Constructors' contract for Concrete Channel Repair Phase I (IFB 20-036) in the amount of \$198,150.00, consider a resolution ratifying the acceptance of "Change Order No. 1" that adjusts quantities within the bid schedule to reflect actual quantities used during construction, resulting in a net decrease in the contract value of \$9,309.48, bringing the new contract value to \$188,840.52.
- 12. In connection with proposals received on April 13, 2021, for Janitorial Services for the District's facility, and based on the Evaluation Committee's recommendation for award, consider a resolution ratifying the execution of an April 26, 2021 "Contract of Janitorial Services" for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (RFP 21-005) with AHC Services with an annual amount not to exceed \$26,116.36.

- 13. In connection with the 5-Year Update to Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's Hazard Mitigation Plan for 2022-2027 (RFQ-21-012), consider a resolution ratifying an award and the execution of a contract with Jeffery S. Ward & Associates, based upon the Evaluation Committee's recommendation for award, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.
- 14. In connection with Request for Qualifications for Professional Engineering Services for Flood Infrastructure Funds Regional Watershed Study (RFQ 21-013) received on June 4, 2021, consider a resolution giving the General Manager authority to award and execute a contract based on the Evaluation Committee's recommendation, with ratification of the contract at the meeting following the award.
- 15. Consider a resolution approving specifications for the Term Contract for Motor Fuel for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (IFB 21-015), authorizing the advertising for bids, and an administrative bid opening for same.
- 16. Consider a resolution approving specifications for the Term Contract for Electrical Services for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (IFB 21-016), authorizing the advertising for bids, and an administrative bid opening for same.
- 17. Consider a resolution approving specifications for the Term Contract for Services to Provide Portable Toilets for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (IFB 21-018), authorizing the advertising for bids, and an administrative bid opening for same.
- 18. Consider a resolution authorizing a Professional Services Agreement (PROF 21-019) for Canal Crossing Condition Assessment between Jefferson County, Drainage District No. 6, and Huitt-Zollars for a contracted amount not to exceed \$50,000.
- 19. Consider a resolution approving specifications for Ditch 110 Channel Repair at BNSF Railroad (IFB 21-020), authorizing the advertising for bids, and an administrative bid opening for same.
- 20. - 21. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch No. 803-A, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by the Estate of Bristol H. Mills, Margaret B. Mills Executrix, consisting of the actual width of Ditch No. 803-A, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditch lies on their property located in Jefferson County, Texas (B.B.B. & C. RR. Co. Survey, Section 98, Abstract 89).
- 22. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch No. 503, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by Robert Havens and wife, Kathy Havens, consisting of the actual width of Ditch No. 503, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditch lies on their property located in Jefferson County, Texas (David Burrell Survey, Abstract 68).
- 23. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a "Letter of Agreement" dated June 3, 2021 between Drainage District No. 6 and Marcus Delacruz (on file in the District's records), wherein the District will perform certain work on his property in exchange for a drainage easement along Ditch No. 503.

Donnell Survey, Abstract 115).
