- H. Business session:
 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received since June 8, 2021, that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 2. Acknowledge the receipt and filing of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's Investment Schedule for June 30, 2021, pursuant to Section 2256.023 of the Public Funds Investment Act.
 - 3. Consider a resolution authorizing Drainage District No. 6's nominee for the Jefferson Central Appraisal District Board of Directors for the 2022-2023 term of office.
 - 4. Consider a resolution authorizing the Jefferson County's Tax Assessor-Collector's office to calculate the "Voter-Approval Tax Rate" pursuant to Texas Water Code Section 49.23602(d), which provides for the calculation under Texas Water Code Section 49.23601, if any part of the district is located in an area declared a disaster area during the current tax year by the Governor or by the President of the United States.
