Public Comments (3 minutes each) – An opportunity for the public to address the Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 Board of Directors on agenda items or concerns not on the agenda – those wishing to speak must complete the blue comment card, present the comment card to the District's Executive Assistant prior to the beginning of the meeting, and observe a three-minute time limit. Members of the public who utilize a translator to address the Board shall be allowed six (6) minutes to address the Board.
- G. Approve the minutes of October 12, 2021.
- H. Business session:
 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received since October 12, 2021, that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 2. Consider a resolution approving a fifth extension of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's existing Depository Contract with Wells Fargo Bank through March 2022, with no changes to the current contract, to allow all business transactions to clear during the transition to Allegiance Bank.
 - 3. Acknowledge the receipt and filing of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's "Investment Schedule for October 31, 2021", pursuant to Section 2256.023 of the Public Funds Investment Act.

4. Consider a resolution authorizing the casting of the District’s 169 votes for Allison Nathan Getz, nominated to serve on the Jefferson Central Appraisal District Board of Directors for the 2022-2023 term of office.
5. Consider a resolution approving the updated “Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 Uniform Tax Abatement Policy-2021.”
6. Pursuant to Section 312 of the Texas Tax Code, consider a resolution authorizing the posting, on November 12, 2021, of Drainage District No. 6’s “Notice of Tax Abatement Consideration” for Coastal Caverns 1 LP Tax Abatement Agreement, which will be brought before the District’s Board of Directors for consideration at their regular meeting on December 14, 2021.
7. Consider a resolution authorizing a “Term Contract with Family Services of Southeast Texas, Inc.” (PROF 21-038), with an effective date of January 1, 2022 and an expiration date of December 31, 2022, at a rate of \$22.00 per employee, per year.
8. In connection with Drainage District No. 6 employee training, consider a resolution ratifying the execution, by the Board President, of a proposal submitted by Dale Carnegie Training of Middle LA and East TX in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00.
9. Pursuant to the authority given the General Manager on October 12, 2021, consider a resolution ratifying an award and the execution of a contract to JSWA, Inc. at the rates noted below, in connection with Professional Services for Grant Application Development and Grant Management for 2021 Funding of Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Program (BRIC), and/or Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program (FMA) Grant Projects (RFP 21-032):

Pursuant to the authority given the General Manager on October 12, 2021, consider a resolution ratifying awards and the execution of a contracts to the firms listed below, in connection with Professional Engineering Services for 2021 Funding of Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Program (BRIC), and/or Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program (FMA) Grant Projects (RFQ 21-033):
 - Freese and Nichols, Inc. Professional Engineering Services Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$56,272.00 (Prof 21-033-FNI);
 - Gauge Engineering Professional Engineering Services Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 (Prof 21-033-Gauge); and
 - Lockwood, Andrews, and Newnam, Inc. Professional Engineering Services Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$51,460.00 (Prof 21-033-LAN).
11. In connection with the Term Contract to Premier Concrete Products, Inc. in the amount of \$137,318.40 for Cellular Concrete Mats for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (IFB 21-028), approved by the Board on September 14, 2021, consider a resolution ratifying the execution of "Change Order No. 1" in the amount of \$34,329.60 for adjustments made to increase the quantity of mats from 180 to 225, bringing the total contract price to \$171,648.00.
12. In connection with the contract awarded to Deztex Industrial Services, LLC d/b/a RAMTEX, in the amount of \$184,900.00 for IFB 21-019/Fleet Maintenance Building Shallow Foundations and Pavement, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of "Change Order No. 02" providing for the modification of eight existing concrete columns, increasing the total contract price by \$8,038.72, for a total contract price of \$208,774.99.
13. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a "Notice of Encroachment License" between Drainage District No. 6 and the City of Beaumont, wherein the City of Beaumont will be granted permission to install 16 flood sensors on Drainage District No. 6 rights-of-way; and pursuant to an Interlocal Agreement approved by the Board on October 12, 2021, approving the waiver of any fees that may be associated with this encroachment license.
14. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch No. 406-C, consider a resolution accepting a "Letter of Release" from Michael and Terri Shilo acknowledging the fulfillment of the Drainage District No. 6's obligations outlined in a Letter of Agreement dated February 25, 2021.
15. In connection with drainage improvements on Ditch 407/North Green Acres Detention, and pursuant to the authority given the District's General Manager and/or Legal Counsel on September 14, 2021, consider a resolution authorizing the acceptance of a "General Warranty Deed" received from Susan McClanahan, Individually and as Independent Administratrix of the Estate of Gloria Duane McClanahan; and the living children of Gloria Duane McClanahan at the time of her death, consisting of a 43.897-acre tract of land out of the Manuel Chirino Survey, Abstract 10, Jefferson County, Texas; and also authorizing payment to said owners in the amount of \$285,500.00 upon closing to be conducted by Texas Regional Title.


16. In connection with drainage improvements on Ditch 407/North Green Acres Detention, and pursuant to the authority given the District's General Manager and/or Legal Counsel on September 14, 2021, consider a resolution authorizing the acceptance of a "General Warranty Deed" received from Thomas B. Parker and Margaret A. Parker consisting of a 14.621-acre tract located in Manuel Chirino Survey, Abstract 10, Jefferson County, Texas; and also approving payment to the Parkers in the amount of \$90,000.00 upon closing to be conducted by Texas Regional Title.
17. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch 106-A (Rena Street), consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by the City of Beaumont across a 0.7787-acre tract of land located in the J.W. Bullock League Abstract 7, Jefferson County, Texas.
18. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch 1205/Byrd Gully, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" received from Toncia C. Simon a/k/a/ Toncia C. Mack consisting of a 0.394-acre tract of land out of the Amory Raines League, Abstract 44, Jefferson County, Texas; and also authorizing payment in the amount of \$2,000.00 for this easement.
19. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch 1205/Byrd Gully, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" received from Terence Joseph Simon consisting of a 0.394-acre tract of land out of the Amory Raines League, Abstract 44, Jefferson County, Texas; and also authorizing payment in the amount of \$2,000.00 for this easement.
20. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a "Letter of Agreement" dated October 13, 2021 between Drainage District No. 6 and Richard Mackan, Jr. (on file in the District's records), wherein Drainage District No. 6 will perform certain work on his property in exchange for a drainage easement along Ditch Nos. 800 and 803.
21. Pursuant to an October 13, 2021 Letter of Agreement, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by Richard Mackan, Jr. in connection with drainage improvements along Ditch Nos. 800 and 803, (McDermand Road), consisting of the actual width of Ditch Nos. 800 and 803, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditches lie on his property located in Jefferson County, Texas (T. & N. O. RR. Co. Survey, Section 46, Abstract 806).
22. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch Nos. 605 and 605-E4, (Hwy-90 & Meeker Road) consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by the Melancon Childrens' Trust, consisting of the actual width of Ditch Nos. 605 and 605-E4, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditches lie on their property located in Jefferson County, Texas (James Gerish Sr. Survey, Abstract 24 and James Gerish Jr. Survey, Abstract 25).
