 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the postponement of the Property Tax Abatement Agreement between Coastal Caverns 1 LP and Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 until a future meeting.

- 10. In connection with BDS Constructors LLC d/b/a MK Constructors contract for Concrete Channel Repair Phase II-Ditch No. 114 (IFB 21-022), consider a resolution ratifying the execution of "Change Order 1" in the amount of \$9,867.60 to incorporate an additional section of the existing concrete channel lining requiring replacement due to a failure that formed after the project was awarded; increasing the total final contract amount from \$419,925.00 to \$429,792.60.
- 11. In connection with "Professional Services Agreement (PROF 21-033)" with Gauge Engineering for Professional Engineering Services for 2021 Funding of Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Program (BRIC), and/or Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program (FMA) Grant Projects (approved on February 11, 2020), consider a resolution authorizing an amendment to the original contract to increase the "not to exceed" value from \$30,000 to \$50,000, an increase of \$20,000, due to the authorized expansion of scope to include professional environmental services.

- 12. Based upon the Evaluation Committee's recommendation and pursuant to the authority given the General Manager on October 12, 2021, consider a resolution ratifying an award and the execution of a contract to Traylor and Associates, Inc., in connection with Professional Services for Grant Application Development and Grant Management for 2021 Funding of Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Program (BRIC), and/or Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program (FMA) Grant Projects (PROF 21-032-Traylor) in an amount not to exceed 5% of the project cost based on the grant funds received.
- 13. In connection with the bid solicitation for the "Term Contract for Grass and Seed Cover (IFB 21-031)," consider a resolution authorizing the rejection of any and all bids received on December 2, 2021, to allow for the re-bid of item(s) once supply chains stabilize.

- 15. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditches 1000 and 1000-A (Keith Rd. & Hwy-105, north Beaumont), consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by Geraldine Conner Barnes, Kirk Joseph Conner, Guadalupe Conner, and Jennifer Conner Dupont consisting of the actual width of Ditches 1000 and 1000-A, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditches lie on their property located in Jefferson County, Texas (D. Easley Survey, A-520).
- 16. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch 502 (Hwy-365, Fannett), consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by Jon G. and Carrie E. Sanders consisting of the actual width of Ditch 502, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditch lies on their property located in Jefferson County, Texas (Manuel Chirino Survey, A-10).
- 17. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditches 804-B and 804-B2 (Kotz Rd. & Hwy 365, Nome), consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by Betty Earl Kotz Estate consisting of the actual width of Ditches 804-B and 804-B2, including improvements, plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditches lie on the estate's property located in Jefferson County, Texas (John Blair Survey, A-4).

- 18. Consider a resolution approving "Agreement for Pipeline/Utility Permit 2021-PL-5" submitted by Chevron Phillips Chemical Company LP requesting permission to install one 12-in line, one 18-in line and one 24-in line transporting natural gas liquids across Ditch Nos. 502 502-A, 502-B, and 502-C using horizonal directional drilling (HDD) method; open cut installations on Ditches 501, 501-A, 501-A3, 501-A4; temporary bridges installed across Ditch Nos. 500-A3, 500-A4, 501, 501-A, 502, 502-A, 502-B; and authorizing a fees associated with this permit totaling \$49,500.00 for 12 HDD crossings, 4 open cut crossings and 7 temporary bridges; and also authorizing a Special Provisions Addendum associated with the permit to allow six months from the start date to complete the project.
