In connection with a Term Contract for Litter Removal Services for District Rights-of-Way and Other Specified Areas for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (Agreement 23-008/KJS), and pursuant to the authority granted to the Interim Chief Operating Officer on May 9, 2023, consider a resolution ratifying the June 13, 2023 execution of an agreement with WorkQuest and Beaumont Products & Services, Inc., with an effective date of July 1, 2023, at a rate of \$19.50/hour and a not to exceed cost of \$20,000.00/year.

In connection with Ditch 202 (Lakeside Dr.-LNVA PA Canal), consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a "Partial Release of Right-of-Way Easement" back to Jo Anne Gay Dishman and Carol Dishman Buckley for a 2.233-acre portion of that certain Right-of-Way Easement described as 14.124 acres out of the C. Williams League, Abstract 59, Jefferson County, Texas (Deed Records Vo. 1588, Pg. 85).
- 30. Ratify the acceptance of a Special Warranty Deed received from PSS Development, LTD in connection with the Amelia Cutoff Project/Ditch 100-E and the payment of \$15,437.35 to PSS Development, LTD, for the conveyance of a 0.810-acre tract of land out of the C. Williams Survey, Abstract 59, Jefferson County, Texas to Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6.
- 31. Ratify the acceptance of a Special Warranty Deed received from Dowlen Extension, LLC in connection with the Amelia Cutoff Project/Ditch 100-E and the payment of \$50,747.22 to Dowlen Extension, LLC, for the conveyance of a 4.642-acre tract of land out of the C. Williams Survey, Abstract 59, Jefferson County, Texas to Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6.
- 32. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of "Storm Drainpipe Tie-In Permit No. 2023-SDP-5" submitted by Five-S Group, requesting permission to install three temporary ditch crossings (each 60 feet long using a single 36-in pipe) on Ditch 560/Knox Gully to provide access for an ongoing construction project; and also approving a permit fee of \$750.00 for same.
- 33. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of "Storm Drainpipe Tie-In Permit No. 2023-SDP-6" submitted by Carlton Sharp, requesting permission to tie two 36-in pipes and one 12-in pipe into Ditch 905-A to serve the Faith Community Development Center on Plant Road in Beaumont; and also approving a permit fee of \$250.00 for same.
- 34. Contingent upon receiving the required insurance documents, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of "Storm Drainpipe Tie-In Permit No. 2023-PL-7" submitted by A. Huston Properties, LLC, requesting permission to tie two 7-ft x 4-ft box culverts into Upper C Detention Pond (Ditch 202-E1) on Phelan Boulevard, which will serve "The Meadows" subdivision in Beaumont; and also approving a permit fee of \$250.00 for same.

- 35. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Application and Agreement for Pipeline/Utility Permit No. 2023-PL-6" submitted by Chevron Phillips Chemical Company LP requesting permission to install a single 12-in pipeline carrying ethylene from a facility on Garner Road to a facility in Port Arthur crossing Ditches 100 (Hillebrandt Bayou), 100-7N, 100-H, and approving fees associated with this permit totaling \$16,000.00 as follows: one crossing on Ditch 100 \$1,000; two open cut crossings on Ditches 100-7N and 100-H \$10,000; and two temporary bridge crossings on Ditches 100-7N and 100-H \$5,000; and also authorizing the execution of a Special Provisions Addendum to extend the construction completion date beyond the standard 120 days due to the size and complexity of the project.
- 36. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Application and Agreement for Pipeline/Utility Permit No. 2023-PL-7" submitted by CenterPoint Energy Resource Corp. requesting permission to install a single 2-in pipeline carrying natural gas across Ditch 001-A at Garner Road in Beaumont; and also approving the waiver of a fee for this permit since the pipeline will be installed entirely within the City of Beaumont's right-of-way.
- 37. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Application and Agreement for Pipeline/Utility Permit No. 2023-PL-8" submitted by CenterPoint Energy Resource Corp. requesting permission to install a single 2-in pipeline carrying natural gas crossing Ditch 001-A at Comstock Road in Beaumont, and also approving the waiver of a fee for this permit since the pipeline will be installed entirely within the City of Beaumont's right-of-way.
- 38. The President to call for an executive session under Title 5, Subchapter D, of the Government Code, Section 551.074 of the Government Code, the Texas open meetings law, to deliberate on personnel matters.
- 39. The Board to Reconvene in Open Session.

Agenda items are not required to be considered in the same order as listed in the Agenda. Any Agenda item(s) may be tabled for Deliberation at a later Meeting, or removed from the Agenda. Any such tabled or removed Agenda item may be placed on an Agenda for a later Meeting for which Notice has been given and posted pursuant to the Act.
