 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received for the month of July 2023, that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 2. Consider a resolution approving the District's 2023 proposed tax rate of \$0.192429/\$100 valuation as distributed below:

- 3. Consider a resolution setting a Public Hearing on Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's proposed tax rate for 2023 of \$0.192429 per \$100 valuation for 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 12, 2023.
- 4. Consider a resolution authorizing the casting of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's 173 votes for Lauren Williams Mason, one of the Conservation and Reclamation Districts' nominees for Jefferson Central Appraisal District Board's 2024 2025 term of office.
- 5. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a "Disclaimer of Interest" in Cause No. 138152, The State of Texas vs. Richmond O. Bennett, III et al., in connection with Condemnation Proceedings filed in the County Court of Law No. 1, Jefferson County, Texas
- 6. Subject to final approval by the District's Legal Counsel and the Chief Operating Officer, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an Engagement Letter with Benckenstein & Oxford, L.L.P. for services related to negotiations for CO₂ Sequestration Agreements/Leases on behalf of Drainage District No. 6.
- 7. In connection with emergency repairs to the drainage infrastructure under Evalon Street in the Calder Place Subdivision, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Interlocal Agreement" (on file in the District's records) between the City of Beaumont ("City") and Drainage District No. 6 ("District"), wherein the City has agreed to secure the necessary repairs and the District has agreed to reimburse the City for 50% of the repair costs in an estimated amount not to exceed \$189,645.00.
- 8. In connection with the inspection of a 102-in culvert on Ditch 005, located between the Port of Beaumont and the ExxonMobil Plant, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Interlocal Agreement" (on file in the District's records) between the City of Beaumont ("City") and Drainage District No. 6 ("District"), wherein the City has agreed to procure an inspector and oversee the culvert inspection, and the District has agreed to reimburse the City for 50% of the inspection costs in an estimated amount not to exceed \$20,000.00.
- 9. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a July 18, 2023 "Letter of Agreement" (on file in the District's records) with Charles Daniels and Frank Daniels, in exchange for the conveyance of a Drainage Easement on their property along Ditches 1207-B and 1207-B1 (Old Grayburg Rd. & Hwy-90, Nome).
- 10. Pursuant to a July 18, 2023 Letter of Agreement, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by Charles Daniels and Frank Daniels, consisting of the actual width of Ditches 1207-B and 1207-B1 plus 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops where the ditches lie on their property located in the August Reuss Survey, Abstract 195, Jefferson County, Texas.
- 11. In connection with the re-bid for the Relocation of Water and Sanitary Sewer Utilities for the McLean Street Project (IFB 22-029/KJS) funded by an FMA grant, and awarded to MK Constructors on January 10, 2023, in the amount of \$396,254.78, this agenda item is to correct the amount of Change Order No. 1 to reflect the summation of the items that are shown to be increased and decreased from (\$8,990.00) to (\$6,050.00), resulting in a new contracted amount of \$390,204.78.
- 12. In connection with the re-bid for the Relocation of Water and Sanitary Sewer Utilities for the McLean Street Project (IFB 22-029/KJS) funded by an FMA grant, and awarded to MK Constructors on January 10, 2023, in the amount of \$396,254.78, consider a resolution approving and authorizing the execution of Change Order No. 2 to adjust various items to reflect actual quantities used in the completion of the project; for an increase of \$6,018.00, resulting in a new contract amount of \$396,222.78.

- 13. In connection with an Invitation for Bids for the Term Contract for Oil and Lubricants (IFB 23-011/SC), consider a resolution granting the Chief Operating Officer the authority to award and execute Acceptance of Offer(s) to bidders representing the best value for the District, with ratification of the award(s) and Acceptance of Offer execution(s) at the meeting following same.
- 14. In connection with a Request for Proposals for Grant Administration and Management Services for Hazard Mitigation Assistance)-Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Funds 2023, Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) Grant Funds 2023, and Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)2023. (RFP 23-010/KJS), consider a resolution granting the Chief Operating Officer the authority to award and execute Acceptance of Offer(s) to proposers representing the best value for the District, with ratification of the award(s) and Acceptance of Offer execution(s) at the meeting following same.
- 15. Contingent upon receipt of the permit fee, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Application and Agreement for Pipeline/Utility Permit No. 2023-PL-9" submitted by ExxonMobil Pipeline Company, LLC requesting permission to perform maintenance on three of their pipelines (10-in, 16-in, and 6-in) located on Ditch No. 100/Hillebrandt Bayou; and also authorizing a fee of \$500.00 associated with this permit.
