- G. Approve the minutes of November 14, 2023.
- H. Business session:
 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received for November and December 2023, that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 2. Acknowledge the receipt and filing of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's Investment Schedule for November 30, 2023 pursuant to Section 2256.023 of the Public Funds Investment Act.
 - 3. Consider a resolution approving an Insurance Consulting and Risk Management Service Agreement with J. S. Edwards and Sherlock Insurance Agency for professional risk management services for one year, with an effective date of January 1, 2024, and expiring December 31, 2024, with s fee of \$6,423.00; no increase in price from the previous year.
 - 4. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of Tax Abatement Agreements between Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 and Golden Triangle Storage LLC for Phase 1 and Phase 2 of Project Gemstone, pursuant to Chapter 312, Texas Property Tax Code.

- 5. Pursuant to Chapter 312, Texas Property Tax Code, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a Tax Abatement Agreement between Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 and Linde, Inc. for their terminal facility in connection with the Golden Triangle Storage LLC Gemstone Project.
- 6. In connection with the Texas Water Development Board Commitment Agreement (TWDB No. G1001280) related to the \$8,500,000 Flood Infrastructure Fund Grant, Project No. 40034 (Regional Watershed Study) approved by the Board on October 12, 2021, consider a resolution acknowledging receipt of TWDB's approval of an amended timeline; and also ratifying the execution of Amendment No. 2 increasing the total completion date of the project to November 2025.
- 7. In connection with the Board of Directors September 12, 2023, approval of carbon sequestration agreements between Jefferson Country Drainage District No .6 and Bayou Bend CCS LLC, pertaining to a 641.852-acre tract of land being all of the Texas & New Orleans Railroad Company Survey, Section 271 (W.S. Benson Survey), Abstract 671 and described in the Special Warranty Deed dated May 21, 2004, from Will L. Ohmstede, Jordan Reese, III, and Peggy Pressler Wood, as Independent Executrix of the Estate of Carlton E. Wood, Jr. Deceased, to Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 and recorded in Instrument No. 2004019968 in the Official Public Records of Jefferson County, Texas, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of the following documents:

Revised Carbon Sequestration Easement Agreement with Bayou Bend CCS LLC;

Revised Confidential Carbon Sequestration Fee Agreement with Bayou Bend CCS LLC; and

Carbon Sequestration Consent Agreement with Bayou Land Conservancy.

- 8. In connection with the City of Beaumont's Street Rehab Project, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a 24-month Lease Agreement with Allco, LLC, providing them temporary access to the District's right-of-way off Folsom Road for use as a laydown yard; and also approving a lease fee of \$1,400 per month.
- 9. Consider a resolution accepting an Access Easement received from Kerrville 50/50 Reality, LLC granting Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 a permanent, 40-ft wide easement on their property to provide access to Ditches 408 and 400 for maintenance and drainage improvements.
- 10. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a "Letter of Agreement" dated November 6, 2023, between Drainage District No. 6, and James Anthony Whitmore Sr. (on file in the District's records), wherein Drainage District No. 6 will perform certain work on his property in exchange for the conveyance of a drainage easement along Ditch 202-C (Washington Blvd. & Major Dr.).
- 11. Pursuant to an authorized Letter of Agreement dated November 6, 2023, consider a resolution accepting a "Drainage Easement" donated by James Anthony Whitmore Sr., in connection with drainage improvements along Ditch 202-C (Washington Blvd. & Major Dr.), consisting of the actual width of the aforementioned ditch, including improvements, plus 15 feet of the ditch tops that lie on their property (Chas. Williams Survey, Abstract 59, Jefferson County, Texas).

12. In connection with the term contract for Corrugated High Density Polyethylene pipe for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (IFB 22-010/KJS) awarded on April 18, 2022, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of the second of four 1-year renewal options, with Coburn Supply as primary supplier (no price change) and ACT Pipe as the secondary supplier (price changes noted below) extending the contract expiration date from December 31, 2023, to December 30, 2024.
