- H. Business session:
 - 1. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received for the months of April and May 2024, that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 2. Acknowledge the receipt and filing of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's Investment Schedule for April 30, 2024, pursuant to Section 2256.023 of the Public Funds Investment Act.
 - 3. Consider a resolution authorizing Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6's nominee for the Jefferson Central Appraisal District Board of Director elections for the 2025 and 2025-2027 terms of office.

- 4. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an "Underground Storage Easement and Agreement" between Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 ("District") and ExxonMobil Low Carbon Solutions Onshore Storage LLC, providing CO² underground storage on property owned by the District in the China Marsh area, and also authorizing the execution of a "Memorandum of Underground Storage Easement and Agreement" for same.
- 5. In connection with drainage improvements along Ditch 107-A, consider a resolution accepting a "Quit Claim Deed" received from Jefferson County consisting of a 5.010-acre tract of land located in the M.C. Cartwright Subdivision, Jefferson County, Texas.

- 13. In connection with the Term Contract for Services of Aerial Herbicide Application for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 (RFP 23-005/KJS), awarded on July 7, 2023, consider a resolution, authorization the execution of the first of four 1-year renewal options, with Industrial Helicopters, extending the contract expiration date from July 6, 2024, to July 5, 2025.
