I. Comments from the board members or staff.

At the request of Mr. Malley, Mr. Heartfield and Mr. Wilson updated the Board on the status of the unauthorized restriction (barge) in Hillebrandt Bayou at Interstate 10 related to TxDOT construction in that area.

Mr. Guillory commented on how good the ditches are looking throughout the District, especially the E. China ditch. He stated that he is receiving a lot of positive comments from citizens throughout the community and thanked the staff for keeping up with the maintenance of the ditches. Mr. Guillory also commented on the Sarah Street Detention Project, noting how great it looks and that citizens are already using the walking path around the basin.

Mr. Daleo thanked the staff for staying on top of the mowing; keep up the excellent work.

Mr. Reneau asked if there has been a study or any thought put into the possibility of extending the Needmore Diversion Channel across the marsh and into the Gulf. Mr. Wilson addressed this question, stating, "Yes, it was in the District's FIF study, but what happens is that the water reaches the marsh and just spreads out, and crossing the GIWW is not a plus at this time."

In response to Mr. Allen's request for an update on the Corely Diversion Project, Mr. Wilson replied that 90% of the plans have been completed and reviewed, but there are still issues with the railroad at MLK.

Ms. Johnson noted for the Board's information that the final public meeting for the FIF Regional Watershed Study Grant will be held on November 17, 2025, at 5:30 pm and will take place at Beaumont's Downtown Event Center.
