 - 1. Recognize Calvin Matthew for his 26 years of devoted service to Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 and wish him well in his retirement.
 - 2. Consider a resolution authorizing the payment of routine bills received for the month of May 2026 that were not expressly authorized or denied for payment elsewhere on this agenda.
 - 3. Acknowledge the receipt and filing of Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6’s “Investment Schedule for April 2026.”
 - 4. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an “Engagement Letter” received from FMW, PC, for the preparation of the District’s basic financial statements for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.


5. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an “Engagement Letter” received from Pollans & Cohen, P.C., for the District’s annual audit for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.
6. In connection with the 2020 Flood Mitigation Assistance Grants (Award EMT-2020-FM-007) for the Ditch 505 Detention Project, E. China Relief Project, and the S. Nome Relief Project, acknowledge the receipt of an “Amendment Memo” received from FEMA wherein the Period of Performance, Liquidation, and Closeout Reporting Deadline dates were extended as follows:
 - Period of Performance:**

Date changed from July 19, 2026 to July 19, 2029; and
 - New Closeout Reporting Deadline:**

7. In connection with the South Nome Relief Project, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of an “Interlocal Agreement” between Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 and the City of Nome, memorializing each party’s agreements concerning improvements to drainage infrastructure within the City of Nome and the City of Nome street rights-of-way.
8. In connection with drainage improvements on Ditch 004-A (area of Martin and Taliaferro Streets), consider a resolution authorizing the acceptance of a “Drainage Easement” donated by the Darryl Coleman Jr. and Curtissa Garrett, consisting of the actual width of Ditch 004-A where it is located on the their property, and 25 feet on each side of the ditch tops that lie on their property located in the A. Williams Survey, Abstract 385, Jefferson County, Texas.
9. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a “Right-of-Way Instrument with Entergy Texas Inc.” conveying Entergy Texas Inc. a permanent, 18-ft Electric Easement, for the installation of utility poles for future development, on a 9.914-acre tract (Parcel 422608) owned by Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6, located off East Clubb Road in the John C. Lawhon Suvey, Abstract 35, Jefferson County, Texas; and also authorizing a one-time fee for this easement of \$3,100.00 (\$5/linear ft).
10. Consider a resolution authorizing the execution of a “Right-of-Way Instrument with Entergy Texas Inc.” conveying Entergy Texas Inc. a permanent, 5-ft x 30-ft Anchor Easement on a 43.897-acre tract (Parcel 126216) owned by Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 and located in the Green Acres area (Manuel Chirino Survey, Abstract 10), Jefferson County, Texas; and also authorizing a one-time fee for this easement of \$500.00.
11. In connection with the “Term Contract for Services of Aerial Herbicide Application for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6” (RFP 23-005/KJS), awarded on July 7, 2023, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of the third of four 1-year renewal options with Industrial Helicopters, extending the contract expiration date from July 4, 2026, to July 3, 2027, with the following rate adjustments:
 - 10 Gallons Per Acre Application Rate - \$45.00 per acre
 - 15 Gallons Per Acre Application Rate - \$53.00 per acre
12. In connection with the “Term Contract for Fencing Materials for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6” (IFB 23-006/SC) awarded on June 27, 2023, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of the third of four 1-year renewal options, with M & J Fertilizer Company, extending the contract expiration date from June 24, 2026, to June 23, 2027, and no other contract changes.

13. In connection with a “Term Contract for Litter Removal Services for District Rights-of-Way and Other Specified Areas for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6” (Agreement 23-008/KJS) awarded to WorkQuest and Beaumont Products & Services, Inc. and ratified on July 11, 2023, consider a resolution authorizing an annual renewal extending the contract effective date from June 28, 2026, to June 27, 2027, and no other contract changes.
14. In connection with the “Term Contract for Hazardous Waste Control for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6” (IFB 23-009/KJS) awarded on July 11, 2023, consider a resolution authorizing the execution of the third of four 1-year renewal options, with E3 Environmental, LLC, extending the contract expiration date from July 8, 2026, to July 7, 2027, and no other contract changes.
15. In connection with the “Term Contract for Herbicides for Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6” (IFB 24-011/SC), ratified by the Board of Directors on July 16, 2024, consider a resolution approving the second of four, 1-year renewal options with Red River Specialties, LLC and Helena Agri-Enterprises, LLC, extending their contract expiration dates from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027, with the price adjustments noted on the schedule below:
